The Great Blessed Massabki Brothers (New Maronite Saints to be canonized in October)

When we think of unshakable Faith a great example of this can be found in the Massabki Brothers. Francis, Abdel Moati and Rafael were brothers, who lived in Damascus, Syria in a devout Maronite family, known for its piety, wealth, nobility, and compassion towards the

poor and needy. In 1860, when the Muslims in Damascus and the Druze in Mount and South Lebanon attacked and massacred the Christians. The Massabki Brothers, accompanied by a large crowd of Christians took refuge in a Franciscan monastery in Damascus after the Muslims had set fire to the Christian neighborhood. They were Praying and celebrating the Mysteries of Reconciliation and Eucharist for the last time. The Massabki Brothers were threatened with death if they did not renounce their Faith. Their response to this threat was, "We are Christians, and faithful to Christ we live and die. We do not fear those who can kill the body, as the Lord Jesus said." Their persecutors attacked them with sticks, knives and axes. This was how they were killed, preferring death over denying their faith in Christ, who crowned them as martyrs. They died on July 10, 1860. Pope Pius XI had them declared Blessed on October 10, 1926. thanks to the efforts of Bishop Bechara Al'Shemali, the Maronite Archbishop of Damascus.

Blessed & Saints Massabki Brothers, Abdal-Moati, Francis and Raphael, pray to the Lord our God for me, for my family and for the Church. Graciously beseech of Him that, like you, I may persevere in love and courage until the destined end, whatever that may be, should find me. May I fear only that which kills the soul, never that which only afflicts the body. May I always have the courage to confess my faith before the world. Amen





Religious Education classes




