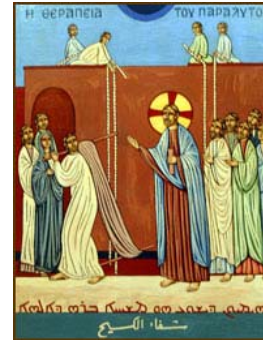
ALL BOOKS ARE TO REMAIN IN THE PEWS AT ALL TIMES.
