PASTOR'S CORNER:

We have solved the problem (temporarily) with the heating & air condition systems in the church. The thermostats have been change to operate on **MY** orders. **DO NOT TOUCH THEM.**

Our units are getting on in years and are at the end of their normal life cycle (they have been in for 16 years). We are keeping the systems running, but we are in immediate need of replacing the unit that services the rear of the church (the end with the double doors!). We have kept this one unit running for the past year on a “thread and a prayer” – the tread is now gone; and the prayer is that we can accrue the funds before it ides!

These units are expensive, but we would like to start a campaign now to gradually build the funds to replace them as the need arises. For now, the one needing replaces is around \$8,000. We are asking you to give what you can toward this expense, and we will replace the unit when we have raised the money.
