OCTOBER THE MONTH OF THE HOLY ROSARY

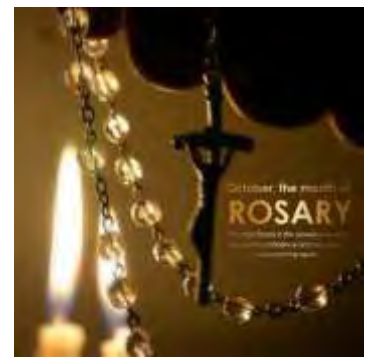
Tradition holds that Mary gave the rosary to St. Dominic (1170-1221) to assist him in combating the Albigensian heresy in 1206 in southern France. The devotion became widely popular and by 1569, Pope St. Pius V officially approved the rosary in its present form with the papal bull, "Consueverunt Romani Pontifices." By then the rosary included the second half of the "Hail Mary" and the "Glory be to the Father" at the conclusion of each mystery.

The month of October is dedicated to the rosary primarily because the **Memorial of Our Lady of the Rosary** is celebrated **Oct. 7**.

This feast of the Holy Rosary was established by Saint Pius V on the anniversary of the naval victory won by the Catholic fleet over Islam at Lepanto, October 7, 1571. The victory was attributed to the direct intervention of the Blessed Mother, through the prayers of the Holy Rosary. The power of the Rosary and the courage of the Catholic navies obtained a historic triumph over the Turks, and saved Christendom from the advancing Turkish power.

Today, we desperately need Our Lady's intervention through the Holy Rosary to turn back the moral, spiritual and physical threat we face as a nation.

Our Lady will overcome all these threats if we turn to Her in confident prayer and courageous action, just like She saved Christendom in 1571.

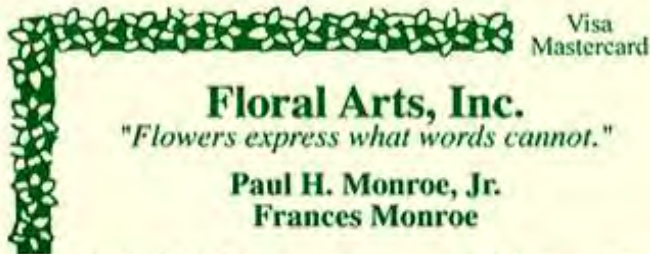
