## 5th Sunday after Holy Cross

### Preparation for the 2023 World Synod

Our Holy Father Pope Francis opened in Rome this last Saturday, a two-year process of preparation for the 2023 XVI Ordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops, under the guiding title, **“For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation and Mission.”** The term “synod” is rooted in Greek, meaning “to walk with” or “journey together.” Throughout our history as Catholics, synods have been convened to walk with one another in the Holy Spirit, to listen and discern how the Church is being called in communion, to respond in faith and to participate in the work of the Gospel and the mission that Our Lord has entrusted to us as the People of God.

This current synodal process will involve a broad consultation and dialogue among the faithful throughout the world and over three phases:

- 1) Local Diocese, discussions and reflections to be compiled into a summary document by April 2022,
- 2) Within nations or regions, the discussions within dioceses of each nation or region to be further compiled into a working document,
- 3) The universal phase - all documents to then be submitted for use in discussions at the Synod itself in Rome in 2023,

We as a parish plan to contribute. For now let us pray to invite the Holy Spirit to guide each phase of this Synod as a community and a people of grace.

*We stand before You, Holy Spirit, as we gather together in Your Name. With You alone to guide us, make Yourself at home in our hearts; Teach us the way we must go and how we are to pursue it.*

*We are weak and sinful; do not let us promote disorder.*

*Do not let ignorance lead us down the wrong path nor partiality influence our actions.*

*Let us find in You our unity so that we may journey together to eternal life and not stray from the way of Truth and what is right.*

*All this we ask of You, who are at work in every place and time, in the communion of the Father and the Son, forever and ever. R: Amen.*

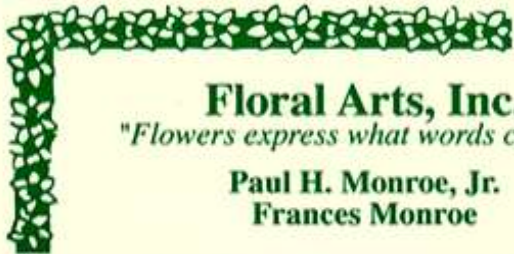

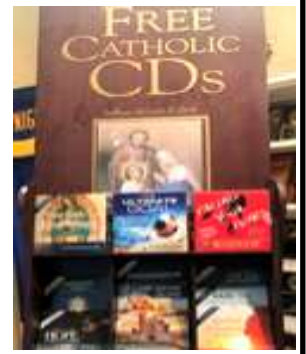
