The Maronite Liturgical Calendar

The Maronite Liturgical Year follows the stages of the life of Jesus Christ: His Birth, Passion, Death and Resurrection, and looks to His Return in Glory.

In just two weeks we will begin a New Liturgical Year in the Maronite Church.

On Sunday November 7th our new year begins with the **Consecration of the Church.**

The liturgical Calendar then proceeds with six seasons:

- 1. Season of Announcements**, leading up to Christmas (the Glorious Birth of our Lord):
- 2. Season of Epiphany** begins January 6th, with special celebrations for the dead the last three Sundays of the Season of Epiphany:
- 3. Season of Lent** always begins with Miracle of Cana on the Sunday of the Entrance into Lent.
- 4. Season of Resurrection** (Seven Sundays of Easter leading to Pentecost)
- 5. Season of Pentecost**
- 6. Season of the Holy Cross**, from September 14, to the end of the liturgical Year

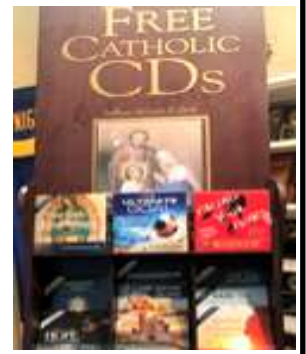

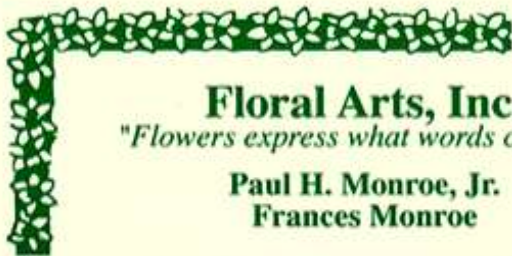

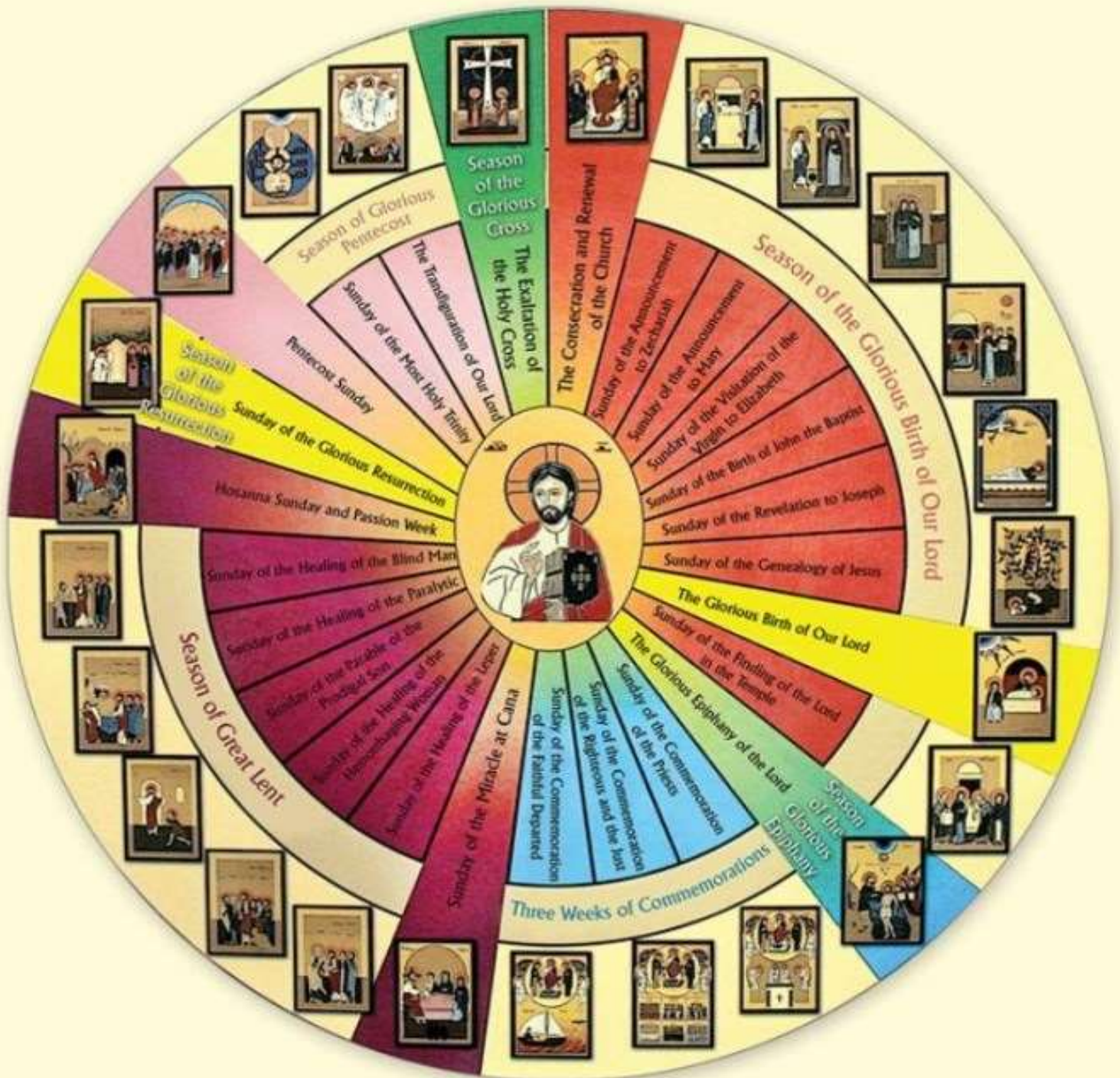
